

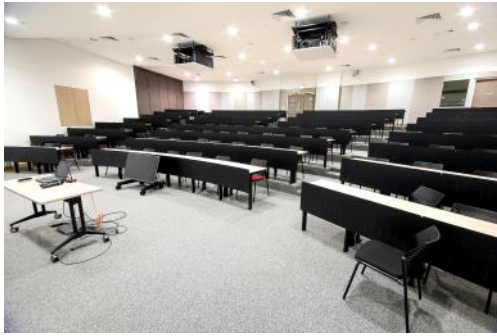
ESSEC's Asia-Pacific Campus in Singapore
